(God's Judgment is Righteous for All 2:6-16)

1. The Principle of Righteousness by Faith 3:21-31

A righteousness from God has been made known

Apart from the Law

Through faith in Jesus to all who believe

All have sinned and fall short of the glory of God

Justification is freely by grace

Through the Redemption that came by Christ Jesus

God presented Jesus as our propitiation

God is just in saving us

Man is justified by faith apart from the Law

This does not nullify the Law, rather it upholds the Law

2. Abraham: Example of Righteousness by Faith 4:1-25

Abraham believed God and it was accounted to him as righteousness 4:1-8

This happened prior to his circumcision 4:9-12

He received the promise by faith, not by law 4:13-22

He is spiritual faith of all who believe 4:16-18, 23-25
